Home Maths Challenges!

Hello everyone! Should you need to stay indoors we have put together a list of maths challenges you could complete at home.

- Look at your clock, what time is it? Can you draw a timetable with the o'clock times and what you are doing?
- Incorporate addition into daily activities. e.g when laying the table. "You have put out 5 plates, what if I add I more?"



- ◆ Can you find items in the home that are shorter or longer than your pencil?
- Can you count how many doors/windows etc your house has. Can you record it on a chart?
- ◆ What 2D shapes can you see around your house? How do you know they are that shape?
- Can you use Lego (or anything else small) to measure things around the home. e.g Barbie is 20 blocks tall.
- ◆ Heavy or Light??? Choose some items and decide which is heavy and which is light.
- Number hunt! Numbers are EVERYWHERE! Where do you see them in your home?
- ◆ Go on a coin hunt and find any loose change in the house. Can you sort them into different types?
- Can you find any 3D shapes in the house? Is it like a cube, cylinder, cone or sphere?
- When building towers, roll a dice and decide whether to add that many blocks or subtract that many blocks. How many blocks are left?

◆ Ordering numbers! Write numbers on cards and mix them up. Can you order them again?
